Albert Bichot Moulin-à-Vent 2014 Domaine de Rochegrès 90 points

Based in Beaune, Burgundy negociant Albert Bichot snapped up this single-vineyard Beaujolais domaine in 2014, and the first vintage under its ownership already shows flashes of Burgundian flair, with a subtly earthy character infusing the rich dark cherry and raspberry fruit, a touch of oaky toastiness and some fine-grained tannins. Serious and cellarworthy for five to ten years.

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
